FEEDING DIRECTIONS

BULL CHALLENGER is especially designed to be fed to growing bulls or cattle that are being developed in the feedlot. It combines roughage, grain and supplement in a total ration.

When new cattle are placed in the feedlot they should be fed according to a CHS NUTRITION starting Program. After this period, gradually switch the animals to BULL CHALLENGER.

Dividing the daily ration into two equal feeding is suggested. Keep fresh feed available to the animals at all times.

It is strongly recommended that this product be bunk fed. Adapting cattle to self-feeders requires additional management to reduce risk of bloat and other digestive disturbances. Because of this, self-feeding is a producer risk.

Although BULL CHALLENGER is intended as a complete feed, the feeder may want to include approximately 10% good quality long roughage in the ration in an effort to minimize management problems.

Usage Tips

Bull Challenger is designed to be fed to growing bulls or animals that are being developed in the feedlot. It is an ideal ration for bulls on a 140-day gain test. It combines roughage, grain and supplement in a total ration that should be fed along with long stem grass hay. When new cattle are placed in the feedlot, they should be fed according to CHS Nutrition's starting program. After this period, gradually adjust the animals to Bull Challenger. The Rumensin option is highly recommended over the non-medicated option.
