FEEDING DIRECTIONS

FOR FREE CHOICE FEEDING: Cattle should consume 1 to 1.5 pounds per head per day depending on their nutritional needs and the quality of other feeds. Offer this product continuously in a lick wheel feeder. Moving the feeder closer to or farther from the water source or the area where cattle normally congregate will help control consumption. Do not feed to hungry or starving cattle. Forages fed with this product should generally be of good quality and offered free choice so that they will adequately supply the remainder of the animal's protein and energy sources.

FOR CONTROLLED FEEDING: Feed to cattle at the rate of 1 to 1.5 pounds per head per day. Thoroughly mix with grain and/or forage prior to feeding.

Free choice salt and fresh, clean water should be available at all times. The need for supplemental free choice mineral feeding will depend upon the kind and amount of ration ingredients being utilized. Ask your dealer and/or feed consultant for assistance in planning a feeding program to meet your specific needs.

CAUTION: For ruminant use only. Do not feed to sheep.
